“Vernal Pool Conservation
in an Era of Climate Change”

Aram is a wetland ecologist whose research focuses on wetland ecology and policy, and vernal pool conservation. Her work stresses the importance of conserving natural resources (wetlands and vernal pools) and target species (wood frogs, spotted salamanders, blue-spotted salamanders) on private lands by addressing both human and ecological dimensions.
