


Keay Brook & Tuckahoe Preserve

Keay Brook and Tuckahoe Preserve form a 217 acre block of conservation land that abuts the sensitive Keay Brook fresh water estuary and the Salmon Falls River. This confluence creates productive bird habitat for species such as the Eastern Towhee and Belted King Fisher. At Keay Brook, a 1 mile trail loops through the preserve and follows an old road bed to a historical bridge crossing. At Tuckahoe, a 1 mile lollipop loop takes hikers down to the Salmon Falls River. Terrain: flat. EASY
