



Orris Falls Conservation Area is a 213 acre preserve with 3.76 miles of trails. This diverse habitat features beaver wetlands, the gorge of Orris Falls, the Littlefield Homestead, a large glacial erratic aptly named Balancing Rock, and the Big Bump with views of Mount Agamenticus from its summit when the trees are free of leaves. The newly constructed Checkerberry Trail connects to the Mt. A trail network. Terrain: hilly with some steep sections. MODERATE to DIFFICULT
